To start the process complete a **PRE** enrolment form and lodged at the centre along with a \$20.00 non-refundable booking fee.

Allocations are open all year round although children must turn 3 years old by April 30th in the year they attend.

Placements are allocated by birth date (oldest to youngest) and are offered in September each year for the following year.
